

Math Facts Pro Privacy Policy

Students not using an account are asked for their names and grade levels. These names are used locally on the printed report at the end of a session. They are not stored. If a student sets a record high score, their first name is used with that high score, if it is in our white list of names (this is how we prevent inappropriate words in high scores). The high scores are erased daily. We do store aggregate anonymous performance data so that we can monitor usage.

When you, the **teacher/parent, create an account**, we ask for your name, email address (optional), time zone, and school/class start/end times. You then enter the following student information: first name, last name (you can use numbers, or made-up names), and grade level. We only use your email address to allow you reset your password/email address, answer your questions, and to send you reports, reminders, and announcements related to your Math Facts Pro account.

When you **pay online** for an account, all financial/address information is handled securely by PayPal. It does not go through our website. The only personal information PayPal shares with us is the email address that was used with the payment.

We will not disclose your email address or any other personally-identifiable information to anyone except trusted third parties who assist us in the operation of MathFactsPro.com.

When your **students log-in** under your account, we collect performance data in order to best help them with becoming fluent in their basic math facts. We also use this data to improve the effectiveness and efficiency of Math Facts Pro. Additionally, we sometimes use this data in an anonymous and/or aggregate form for marketing purposes.

Users may submit **joke/riddle videos** for our use on Math Facts Pro. Videos of minors are to be submitted by parents/legal guardians only if they approve of the video being posted. Video submissions become the sole property of Math Facts Pro. If we approve a submission for use on the site, we will send the parent/legal guardian a link via email with which they can approve/disapprove the video, and we will not show the video to users until/unless it is approved. If at any time a parent or child wishes to have a video removed, they simply need to let us know the number and their name.

We implement a variety of security measures to maintain the safety of your personal information. We will remove all of your information from our system upon request.

Math Facts Pro stores your username on your computer to assist you the next time you sign-in. We also use cookies to track aggregate usage statistics through Google Analytics.

All personal information collected for use on the Math Facts Pro website is kept confidential. No personal information is sold, traded, or distributed to other agencies or organizations.
